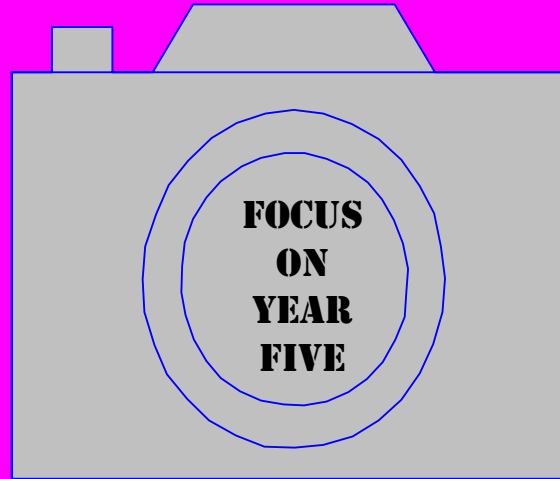


TERM 1: Endangered Species
