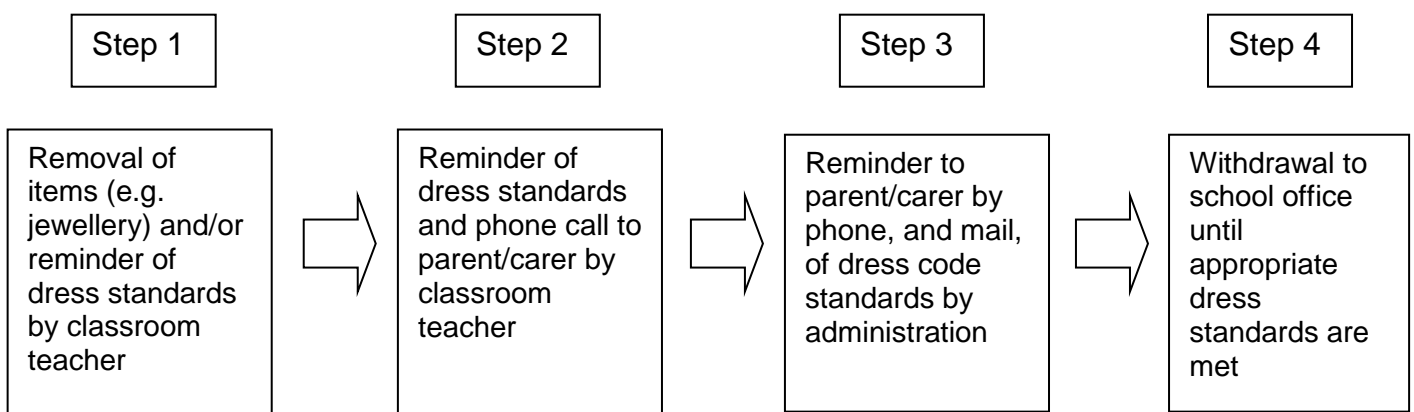
## Dress Code



The Student Dress Code and Uniform Policy was established under Part 10 of the Education Act (General Provisions) 2006. Ormeau State School and the Parents' and Citizens' Association support the ideals behind the policy, therefore children are required to wear the school uniform that is available from the school uniform shop. Uniform order forms are available from the school office.

Bottoms	OSS Uniform Shorts/Culottes/Skirt
Shirt	OSS Uniform Shirt
Hat	(Years 1-6) OSS Cap or OSS Bucket Hat/Wide-brimmed Hat (Prep) Light Blue OSS Bucket Hat
Shoes	Predominantly Black or Predominantly White Shoes with Black or White Laces
Socks	White Socks
Hair	Neatly presented with no coloured dye. Hair past collar length must be tied up. Hair tracks, rat tails and mohawks are <b>not</b> permitted. Blue hair accessories only
Presentation	Neat and tidy presentation with no visible body art (including make-up) or nail polish
Winter Uniform	OSS Uniform Jumper/Zipper Jacket. Navy Blue Long Pants or Stockings Hoods are <b>not</b> permitted
Jewellery	One pair of sleepers or studs in the ears and watch only. No other jewellery acceptable

### Failure to Wear Correct Uniform



Wearing of incorrect uniform may result in child being excluded from external school activity

Clothing with inappropriate slogans and/or insignia will not be tolerated under any circumstances. Parent/carer will be required to bring a change of clothing to school. Child will complete school work in office area until this time.
