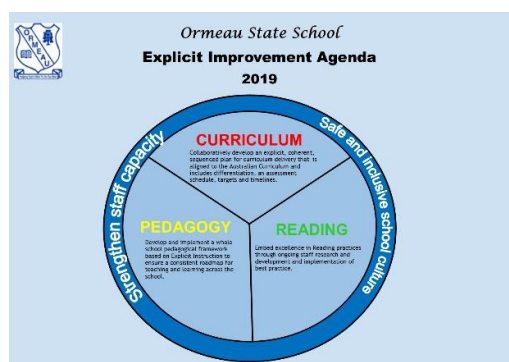


Investing for Success

This funding will be used to

Provide valuable resources for our school to reach it's targets of:

- 85% students P-6 achieving A-C in English
- 45% students in P-6 achieving A/B in English and Maths
- 50% students achieving in the Upper 2 Bands in NAPLAN Year 3 Reading
- 35% students achieving in the Upper 2 Bands in NAPLAN Year 5 Reading
- 100% of students reaching the National Minimum Standard for Reading in NAPLAN

Our initiatives include

- Continuation of MiniLit and MacqLit intervention programs including the purchase of resources and teacher aide time to deliver the programs
- Strengthening staff capacity in Explicit Instruction through appointment of a pedagogical coach
- Additional teacher aide time to support differentiated instruction of reading across the school
- Increase employment of Speech language Pathologist to two days per week to support staff and students in enhancing oral language skills across the school.
