

Family sharing is the only way you can set up your child's iPad.

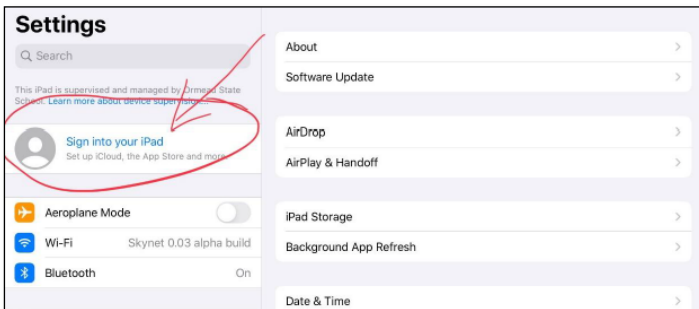
(Children under the age of 13 cannot create their own Apple ID – it must be created under a parent/guardian account).

PART ONE: Parent Apple Account



Step One

- Open settings app on an Apple device (iPad or iPhone)



Step Two

- Select "sign into your iPad" (or iPhone)

(NB If someone other than you is signed in, sign them out).

Step Three

If you have an Apple ID

- Enter details, then:
 - move to next section to set up Family Sharing

If you don't have an Apple ID

- Select "Don't have an Apple ID or forgot it?", and:
 - Follow prompts to create a parent/guardian Apple ID before moving onto set up Family Sharing



*NB: All Apple ID accounts must be linked to a valid payment method (e.g credit card)

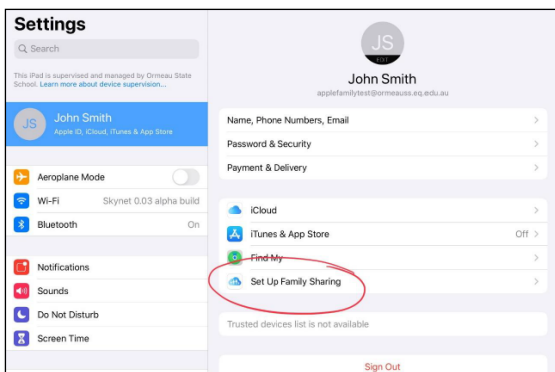
Once a Parent/Guardian Apple ID is set up:

PART TWO: Setting up Family Sharing



Step One

- Open settings app on the iPad (or iPhone)
- Select "your name" (e.g. John Smith)



Step Two

- Select "Set up Family Sharing"

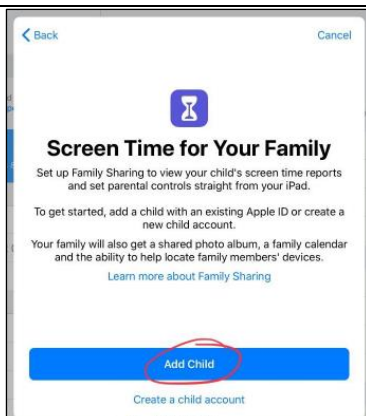
Step Three

- Select "Get Started"



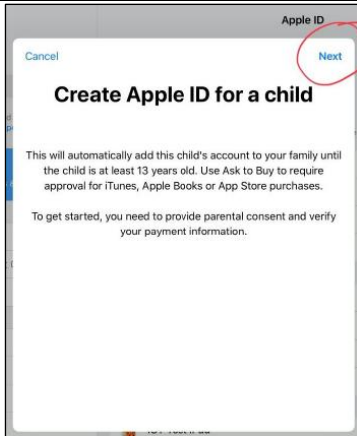
Step Four

- Click "Screen Time" in the Get Started menu



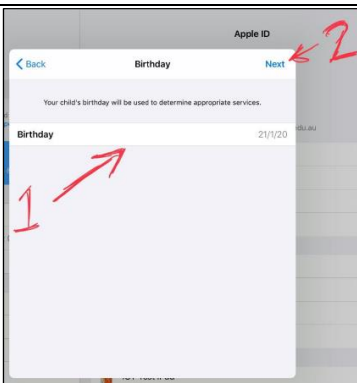
Step Five

- Select "Add Child"



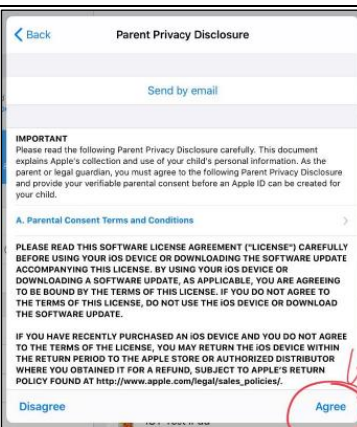
Step Six

- Click "Next" in the Create Apple ID for a child prompt



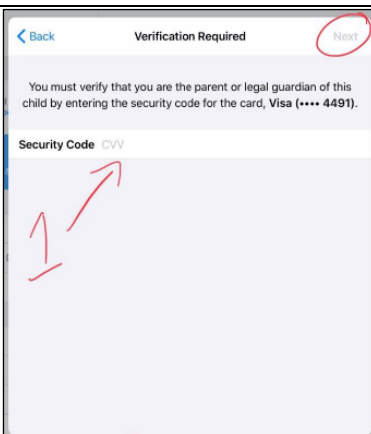
Step Seven

- Enter the child's birthday
- Click "Next"



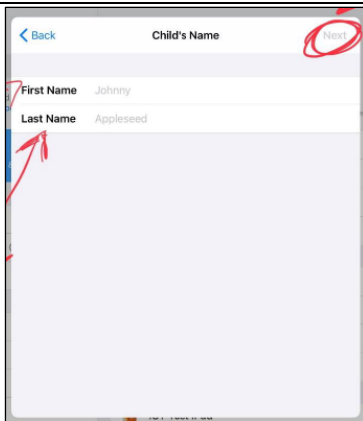
Step Eight

- Read the Parent Privacy Disclosure
- Click "Agree"



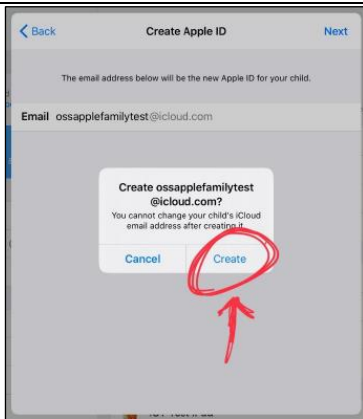
Step Nine

- Verify the account by using the CCV of the bank card attached to the Parent Apple ID
- Click "Next"



Step Ten

- Enter the child's name
- Click "Next"



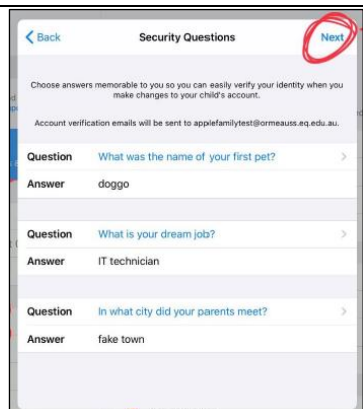
Step Eleven

- Create an email for your child
(something identifiable and professional as they will be able to keep this email account for life)
- Click "Create"







Step Twelve

- Create a password that both you and your child will remember
- Verify the password
- Click "Next"



Step Thirteen

- Create security questions
- Click "Next"

	<p>Step Fourteen</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Ensure the “Ask to Buy” toggle is switched on (green) <p>(this means your child cannot make purchases without your permission first)</p>
	<p>Step Fifteen</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Read the “Terms and Conditions” <input type="checkbox"/> Click “Agree”
	<p>Step Sixteen</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Click “Continue” to set up screen time restrictions (highly recommended)
	<p>Step Seventeen</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Click “Done” to finalise Family Sharing <input type="checkbox"/> Click “Add Another Child” if you need to create another Child Apple ID
	<p>Step Eighteen</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Sign out of the iPad (if on child’s iPad) <input type="checkbox"/> Sign your child into the iPad with their newly created email and password <p>Your child’s iPad is now ready for them to use at school!</p>
