

# Setting up Parental Controls on the iPad



Parental controls are tools that allow parents to manage their children's device usage and internet access.

They can be set at:

- network level (e.g. to manage all devices connected to your home Wi-Fi)
- device level (e.g. allows parents to manage that device no matter where it is)

## How to activate parental controls

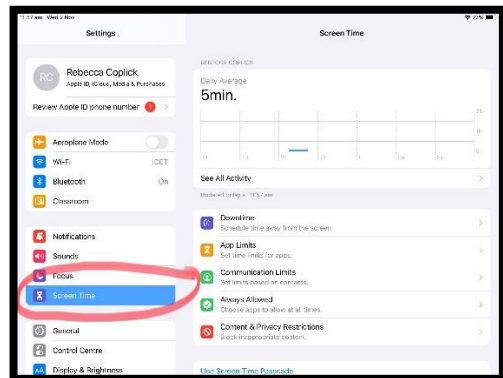
Step 1

Open settings app on iPad



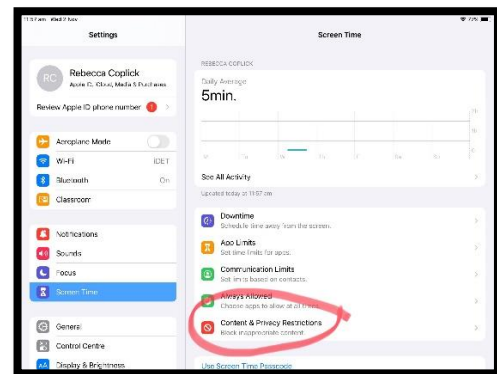
Step 2

Select **"Screen Time"**



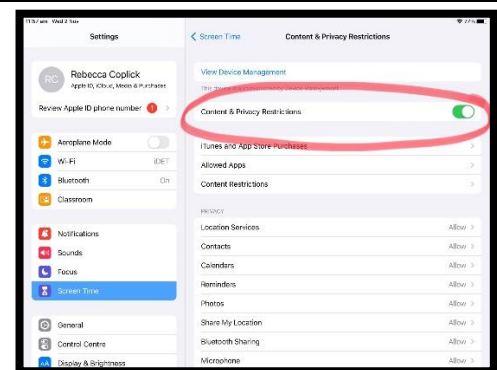
Step 3

Select **"Content & Privacy Restrictions"**



Step 4

Ensure the **"Content and Privacy Restrictions"** toggle is on (should be green)

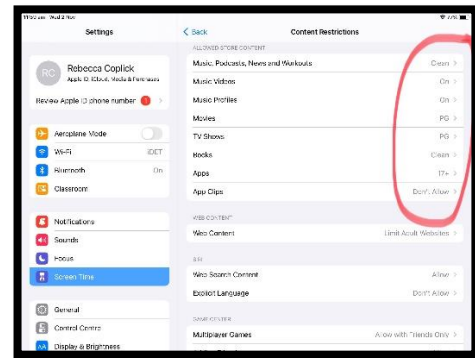


# Setting up Parental Controls on the iPad



## Step 5

Work through the list of options on the right-hand side to select age appropriate options



## Step 6

Create a **“Screen Time Passcode”** to secure the selected options

**NOTE:** When prompted, use your parent Apple ID and password to ensure that the passcode cannot be changed by your child
